We believe that to want children to look after our planet, our children need to **know about our planet and love it!** This is why we have a Forest School curriculum based on the Wild Passport scheme. Our trained Forest School Lead Helen Carver, leads all **Forest school sessions** with individual year groups.

Children progress from using simple peelers to using wood drills in our tool use programme; creating nests to building a-frames and putting up tents in our **den building programme**.

Each session is well-resourced so children can consolidate previous learning and be creative with the skills they have.

It also provides an opportunity to face **different challenges outside of the classroom** which helps develop **resilience**.

Finally, we believe it helps develop those all important relationships between children and develops shared memories.
