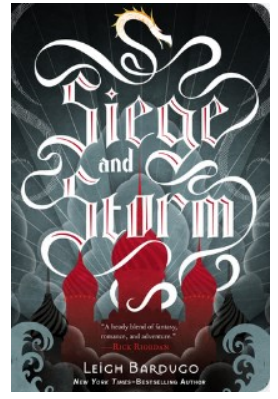
Mr Parker and Vicki were accompanied by Helen Carver, Nancledra's very own Forest School Leader, so the children benefitted from some extra activities in the evenings.
