### Length of the School Week

The white paper "Opportunity for all: strong schools with great teachers for your child" sets an expectation that all state-funded mainstream schools will deliver a minimum length of school week of 32.5 hours as soon as they can, and from September 2023 at the latest.

For Nancludra School this means we will be offering a 6.5 hour school day from September 2023.

There will be an adjustment to registration time from 8.55am to 8.45pm, and the school will open from 8.30am instead of 8.40am.

At the end of the day, the official "home time" will be 3.15pm. However, for safeguarding reasons in the car park, we will still stagger the end of the day for our younger children so that Class 1 & Class 2 can be collected from 3.10pm.
