About the artist

Andy Warhol was well known for his pop art screen prints. He made films, paintings and sculptures too. He had a shock of white hair, wore black leather jackets and sunglasses. Warhol's studio in New York City was called The Factory

printmaking

noun



Meaning

An indirect art form, where the artist creates a design on a block, plate or screen which is then transferred to paper or fabric by pressing with printing ink.

monoprint

noun



Meaning

The monoprint is a form of printmaking where the image can only be made once.

screen printing

noun



Meaning

Printing where printing ink is forced through the small holes in a piece of material. A picture pattern is made by covering some of the holes with a stencil.

etching

noun



Meaning

A print made by cutting lines into a metal plate by applying acid

relief printing

positive



Meaning

Printing created by ink raised parts of a printing block e.g., woodcut/wood engraving and linocut.

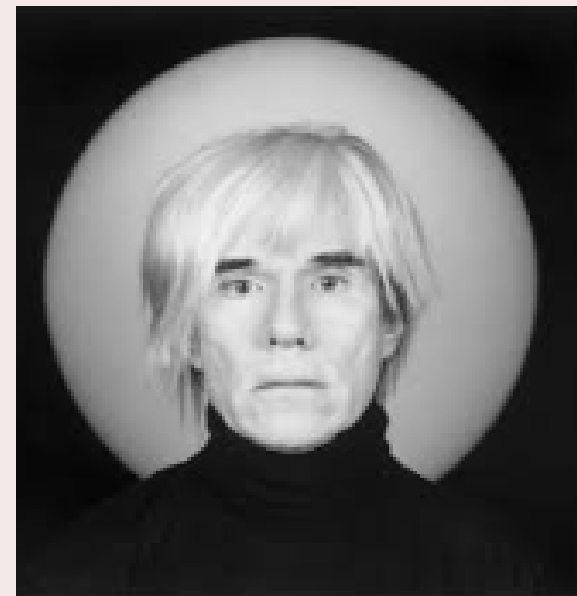
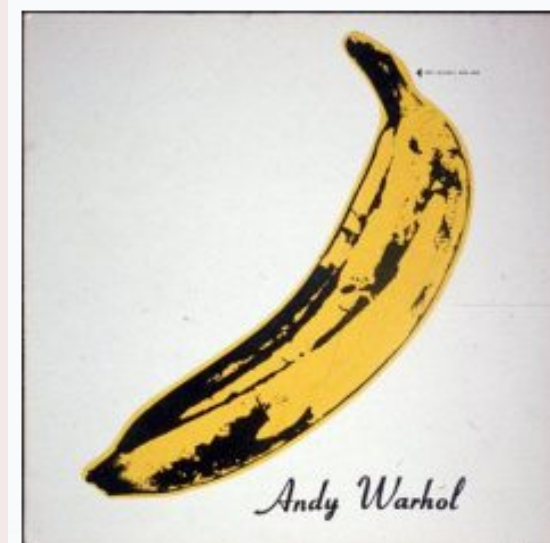
intaglio printing

Meaning

Printing created by ink covering the sunken parts of a printing plate e.g., dry point, engraving, etching.
